Homestays are located throughout the city of Valencia with convenient access to public transportation. Students can easily commute to and from the University.

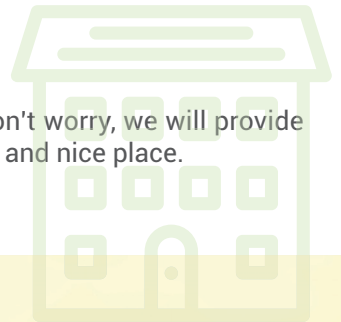


Students will be able to **request a homestay** during the application process. Cost: 1081,08 EUR

APPLICATION

Application is open until 1st April 2023

Students will need:

- **ID/Passport copy**
- **Insurance policy**
- **A2 Spanish Level**
- **Pay the 580 euros course fee**

You may receive an **Erasmus+ grant** as a contribution to your travel and subsistence costs.

If you are moving **between Programme countries**, check with your National Agency and your sending higher education institution for applicable rates and procedures.

VISA INFORMATION

During your online application, you will be asked if you require a **Visa support letter**, which we will send you once your fees have been paid.

We recommend applying for a visa at least **one month before your departure date** and we advise you to check it with your local visa office as well.
